

The meeting of AAA committee was fixed on 16-09-2019. The AAA committee was assisted by the IQAC members for conducting the audit. The Committee had a formal meeting with the Principal, Deans, Head of Departments and the coordinators during which the Principal presented the overview of the institute, developments and the achievements made. Members of the Committee were briefed about the objective of the audit and the procedure involved.
